

## **Free and Reduced Priced Meals Program Application Information**

All principal's offices at Millard Public School District will have the current version of the Free and Reduced Priced Meals Program applications available in both English and Spanish from late July before school begins through the entire school year. Parents can apply at any time during the school year to see if their family qualifies for this program. Applications are assembled into packets from several pages and sources, so applications are not available online at present.

**FAMILIES:** Only one application should be completed for an entire family, even if there are children in more than one Millard school.

**FOSTER CHILDREN:** Foster parents need to fill out a separate application for each foster child. Foster children should not be included with the family's application since each foster child is considered a household of one by the USDA.

Original signatures are required on the applications (no faxes). Applications can be mailed or delivered to any Millard school office or can be sent to:
